In accordance with Prince of Songkla University's policies to increase international student admission opportunities, to support undergraduate internationalization, and to turn the university into an ASEAN Education Hub, the following undergraduate admission policies are in effect for academic year 2020

#### 1. Applicant's qualifications

- 1.1 Eligibility
  - 1.1.1 Thai or international students who are studying in other countries.
  - 1.1.2 Students who are studying in or having completed senior high school or equivalent.
- 1.2 Specific Qualifications required by each faculty or program

#### 2. Application Procedures

- 2.2 Applicants will be able to choose one program in each admission round except those who have confirmed their online confirmation report in TCAS system of Association of The Council of University Presidents of Thailand

- 2.4 Complete the online application on the website http://www.entrance.psu.ac.th/foreign
  - In addition to providing information in the form, attach a two-inch photo (facing directly toward the camera, no glasses or cap)
- 2.5 Provide the following documents in pdf format:
  - -A certified copy of senior high school certificate or certificate of student status (for students who are studying in Senior High School or equivalent) or a certified copy of either one of the following certificates: IGCSE, GED or IB
  - A certified copy of the identification card (for Thai student) or passport (for international student)
  - -Other supporting documents specified by each program, such as a certificate identifying special skills, English language test results taken within the preceding two years (if applicable), etc.
- <u>Remarks</u>: 1. All required documents must be in <u>English only</u> (documents in any other languages must be translated into English, with an official stamp)
