

# Prince of Songkla University Annoucement Direct Admission Channel for PSUIC Digital Gifted Bachelor of Science (Digital Media) International College Academic Year 2020

Prince of Songkla University offers the Direct Admission Channel for Bachelor of Science (Digital Media), International College, for PSUIC Digital Gifted for the academic year 2020. Following is a list of the conditions and requirements of the enrollment.

## 1. Qualifications

- 1.1 Students in Thai educational system/curriculum.
  - 1.1.1 who are studying Matthayom 6 in Thailand
    - 1) Science-Math Track, Math-English Track, Art-Languages Track
    - 2) GPAX for 5 semesters (Matthayom 4 Matthayom 6-first semester) at least 2.5 and the Languages Track (English)-GPAX for 5 semesters at least 2.5
    - 3) Any cases not complied with the aforementioned clause 1) and or 2) will be considered by the Recruitment Committee or
  - 1.1.2 who have completed Matthayom 6 in Thailand or equivalent
    - 1) Science-Math Track, Math-English Track, Art-Languages Track
    - 2) GPAX for 6 semesters (Matthayom 4 Matthayom 6) at least 2.5 and the Languages Track (English)-GPAX for 6 semesters at least 2.5
    - 3) Any cases not complied with the aforementioned clause 1) and or 2) will be considered by the Recruitment Committee or
  - 1.1.3 Vocational certificate in Computer, Information Technology, or Fine Arts
- 1.2 Students in foreign educational system/international curriculum.
  - 1.2.1 who are studying or have completed Senior High Schools or equivalent from International Schools in Thailand or in other countries certified by Equivalent Qualification Announcement of Ministry of Education or
  - 1.2.2 Students are required to pass any of the following degrees;
    - IGCSE (International General Certificate of Secondary Education) with the result of at least "C" for 5 different subjects in O-Level and 3 subjects for A Level or
    - GED (General Educational Development) certified by Ministry of Education Thailand with the result of at least 145 scores each for 4 subjects or
    - IB (International Baccalaureate)
  - 1.2.3 Apart from above qualifications, applicants will be considered case by case by the Recruitment Committee.

## 2. Specific Qualifications

- 2.1 Portfolio related to digital media or art work which show applicants' creative skills and the ability to create artistic work.
- 2.2 Certificate(s) from competition(s) related to art & creativity contest which shows that the applicant won the award or prize of any level in such contest.

## 3. Expected Number of Students

10 students

*Note:* The number of students is adjustable as appropriate.

## 4. Application Process

- 4.1 Application documents
  - 1. Completed application form (with one 3x4-cm photo)
  - 2. For Thai students
    - A certified copy of academic transcript of Matthayom 4 6 (5 semesters).

## For foreign students

- A certified copy of academic transcript and;
- A certified copy of graduation certificate in Senior High School or equivalent degree or;
- A certified copy of IGCSE, GED or IB result.
- Awarded certificate(s) or portfolio(s) related to Digital Media work (maximum 10 A4 pages).
- 4. A certified copy of Thai identity card for Thai students, or passport for foreign students.

Remarks: copies of all documents must be certified.

## 6. Selection Criteria

Interviewees are required to present their work within 10 minutes to demonstrate their English ability and digital media related skills. Student performance and attitude will be evaluated by the Recruitment Committee, based on the following criteria:

## 7. Scholarship

PSUIC offers 7 scholarships for accepted students recruited through Direct Admission Channels as follows:

100% tuition fee waive throughout the whole study
 50% tuition fee waive throughout the whole study
 25% tuition fee waive throughout the whole study
 4 scholarships

## Applicant requirements

- 1. Documents and qualifications
  - 1.1 Portfolio and
  - 1.2 English test score
    - -IELTS ≥5 or
    - -TOEFL (Paper-based  $\geq$ 500, Computer-based  $\geq$ 173, Internet-based  $\geq$  61) or
    - -TOEIC  $\geq$  600 or
    - -PSU-GET ≥70%.
    - -Other scores accepted by the University and/or
  - 1.3 Projects or work related to digital media which won the competition in national or international level and/or
- 2. Interview scoring criteria
  - 40% for work / portfolio presentation
  - 40% for English communication (Listening and Speaking skills)
  - 20% for attitude and passion towards the program and institution

Remarks: Candidate must get at least 80% of the total score in each interview scoring criteria.

- 3. *The highest scholarship*\* will be granted to the applicants who earn the highest score from the committee and the lower scholarship to the lower rankings respectively.
  - Remark: \* the highest scholarship granted for each year is not limited to only 100% tuition fee waive. It depends on candidate's performance to deserve which level of the scholarship. The consideration is upon the committee
- 4. In case that the candidate's qualifications and performance do not meet the expectation of the committee, PSUIC will reserve the right to offer the scholarship.

#### 8. Enrollment Conditions

- 8.1 Successful applicants must complete their study in secondary school or equivalent within the same academic year.
- 8.2 Applicants from Science-Math and Math-English tracks must earn at least 12 credits from Mathematics subjects' group.
- 8.3 Successful applicants must submit the original graduation certificate on the student report and registration day.
- 8.4 Successful applicants must submit one English test score of the following tests: IELTS ≥4.5 or TOEFL (Paper–based ≥470, Computer–based ≥150, Internet–based ≥50) or TOEIC ≥ 450

or PSU-GET ≥60%. In case of being unable to provide the above evidence in due time, students must attend PSUIC Preparatory Course in academic year 2020.

- 8.5 Applicants who submit false documents will be disqualified.
- 8.6 In case that scholarship recipients referred in 7. would like to transfer to another faculty or resign from PSUIC, they must repay in full amount of received scholarship.

## 9. Tuition Fee Payment and New Student Enrollment

All-inclusive tuition fee is 85,000 THB per semester.

More information can be followed up on the Registrar Division's website.

## 10. Confirmation to study at PSU through TCAS system

Successful applicants must confirm their status to study at PSU during 30 – 31 January 2020 in TCAS system on the website: https://student.mytcas.com, otherwise, the university reserves the right to cancel the acceptance of study.

## 11. Rejection of acceptance to study at the university

Once having confirmed the status to study at PSUIC in TCAS system, in case that the applicants would like to cancel the confirmation, the cancellation must be done within the specified period by the Council of University Presidents of Thailand.

#### 12. Final admission results announcement

The university will announce the final name list of admitted applicants on 4 February, 2010 through www.entrance.psu.ac.th and www.uic.psu.ac.th

#### 13. PSU Conditions for Graduation

- 13.1 Students must study and pass all the required assessments according to the curriculum requirements.
- 13.2 Students must pass the minimum criteria of English requirements specified by the University.
