1. Applicant's qualifications

 - 1.1.2 Students who are studying in or have completed the senior high school or equivalent.
- 1.2 Specific Qualifications required by each faculty or program

2. Application Procedures

- 2.1 Registration via the Thai University Central Admission System (TCAS) system All applicants must register and confirm the identity in TCAS system which is under The Council of University Presidents of Thailand on the website: https://student.mytcas.com
- 2.2 Applicants will be able to choose one program in each admission round except those who have validate their online confirmation report in TCAS system of The Council of University Presidents of Thailand.
- 2.3 Check all information from faculty/college about programs offered and qualifications required in this announcement.
- 2.4 Complete the online application on the website https://e-admission.psu.ac.th
- 2.5 Provide the following documents in PDF format:
 - A certified copy of senior high school certificate or certificate of student status (for students who are still studying in the Senior High School or equivalent), or a certified copy of either one of the following certificates: IGCSE, GED or IB
 - A certified copy of the identification card (for Thai student) or passport (for international student)
- <u>Remarks</u>: 1. All required documents must be in <u>English only</u> (documents in any other languages must be translated into English, with an official stamp).
 - 2. All documents must be certified.
 - 3. Documents in 2.5 must be merged into one file (pdf file) and upload through application system.
