1. Applicant Qualifications

1.1 For students educated in Thai programs

- Must have completed or are studying at Mattayom 6 level or equivalent in a domestic. or

1.2 For students educated in a foreign educational institution or abroad.

- Must have completed or are studying at senior high school or equivalent in a foreign educational institution or abroad which have received foreign qualifications from the Ministry of Education.

1.3 Do not have any contagious or serious diseases which would be an obstacle to study.

1.4 Must be an individual of good behavior who can guarantee to the university that they are committed to

studying to the best of their ability and are willing to strictly follow all current and future university regulations. 2. Scholarships will be awarded to students who are admitted through TCAS Round 1. Each scholarship is worth 10,000 baht per semester, only for the first semester of the first year of study. (There are 3 scholarships per school. If there are more than 3 people who meet the criteria from the same school, the International College Committee will be the final authority.)

3. The interview will assess the applicant's ability to communicate in English. If the applicant does not meet the criteria, they will be disqualified from the interview.

# 4. Applications and Supporting documents

4.1 Application documents

Applicants fill out the application form via https://e-admission.psu.ac.th and submit supporting

documents of accompanying evidence by formatting .pdf only one file including:

- 1) A copy of the academic transcript (transcript 1) (front and back) (for students with 4 semesters of academic results / for graduates with 6 semesters of academic results) 1 set
- 2) A copy of the national identification card
- 3) A portfolio of work, no more than 10 pages
- 4) Other relevant documents/certificates
- 4.2 Application Process
  - 1. Students who are eligible to apply must submit their application online between October 1 and 30, 2023, at https://e-admission.psu.ac.th. The system will close at 23:00 on the last day of the application period.
  - 2. Students who are eligible to apply must submit their application online between October 1 and 30, 2023, at the website. The system will close at 23:00 on the last day of the application period.
- 6. criteria for selection

1) The selection committee will select students who are eligible for an interview by selecting from applicants who meet all of the required criteria. If an applicant does not meet the specified criteria, they will not be considered for an interview.

2) The interview and other information of the applicant The decision of the selection committee of Prince of Songkla University is final.

### 7. Announcement of Applicants Who Have Passed the Interview

## 8. Confirmation of eligibility in the system (through the TCAS system)

Those who passed the interview and were selected must confirm their enrollment during February 6-7, 2023, through the TCAS (Thai University Central Admissions System) system on the website https://student.mytcas.com Otherwise, it will be considered that they have waived their right to study at Prince of Songkla University.

## 9. Waiving the right to study

Those who have confirmed their enrollment under this program will be disqualified from admission in the next round. If you wish to waive your right, please do so in the TCAS system during the period specified by the TCAS Association.

10. Announcement of the names of those who are eligible to study

The university will announce the names of those who are eligible to study on February 13, 2023, via https://admission.psu.ac.th

#### 11. Conditions for Graduation from Prince of Songkla University

1. Students must complete all courses and assessments in accordance with the curriculum,

requirements, and conditions of the major, and in accordance with the regulations of Prince of Songkla University.

2. Students must pass an English proficiency test that meets the minimum standards set by Prince of Songkla University.

#### 12. Payment of tuition fees and registration as a student

Those who have been selected are not considered students of Prince of Songkla University until they have been registered as students of Prince of Songkla University. To apply for student registration and the opening of the semester, you must report to the university on the date, time, and place specified by the university.
