



## Prince of Songkla University Announcement

**Subject: Undergraduate Admission and Selection for the Faculty of Engineering, Innovation Engineering and Management (International Program)  
Under the Portfolio General Project Group for the Academic Year 2025 (Round 1/1)**

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The Faculty of Engineering at Prince of Songkla University wishes to open applications and select individuals for undergraduate studies in the Bachelor Degree Program in Innovation Engineering and Management (International Program), Academic year 2025 Round 1/1. Details are as follows:

### 1. General qualifications of applicants

- 1.1 Students from the domestic school system are those who are currently studying or have graduated from high school with a focus on science and mathematics subjects.
- 1.2 Students in the international school system: Applicants who are currently studying or have completed high school or an equivalent level from an international education system institution, either in Thailand or abroad, or have equivalent educational qualification examination results.
- 1.3 Applicants must have proficiency in English communication and/or possess English language proficiency test results, such as IELTS, TOEFL, or TOEIC, that are no older than 2 years from the application date
- 1.4 Applicants must not have any serious contagious diseases or conditions that would hinder their studies or future career
- 1.5 Applicants must have good conduct.
- 1.6 Applicants must take a written and spoken English proficiency test on the interview day based on topics specified by the program. (Applicants who have graduated from international or foreign schools will be exempted).

However, in each semester, students must enroll according to the study plan or at least 18 credits in 6 regular semesters (with the exception of fourth-year students, who will be considered on a case-by-case basis if not enrolled as per the study plan).</li> </ol>		

### 3. Application Schedule

Date	Application Process
1 October - 7 November 2024	Applicants must register for a username and password through the website at <a href="https://e-admission.psu.ac.th">https://e-admission.psu.ac.th</a> . Online application submission and information editing can be done through the website at <a href="https://e-admission.psu.ac.th">https://e-admission.psu.ac.th</a> . The system closes at 11:00 PM on the application deadline date.
1 October - 8 November 2024	Pay the application fee of 500 THB by scanning the QR Code using a bank's mobile application displayed on the payment page. (The payment must be completed by 11:59 PM.)
From 28 October 2024 onwards	All applicants must register and verify their identity through the TCAS system of the Council of University Presidents of Thailand at <a href="https://student.mycas.com">https://student.mycas.com</a> to confirm their application rights.
11 November 2024	The list of selected applicants for interviews will be announced on the website <a href="https://www.eng.psu.ac.th/tcas">https://www.eng.psu.ac.th/tcas</a>
15 November 2024	The interview will be conducted online.
19 November 2024	The list of successful interviewees will be announced on the website <a href="https://www.eng.psu.ac.th/tcas">https://www.eng.psu.ac.th/tcas</a>
5 - 6 February 2025	Selected applicants must confirm their admission via the TCAS system at <a href="https://student.mycas.com">https://student.mycas.com</a> under the Council of University Presidents of Thailand.

11 February 2025	The university will announce the list of admitted students on the website <a href="https://admission.psu.ac.th">https://admission.psu.ac.th</a> .
May – June 2025	Students must officially register and pay their tuition fees. Further details can be followed on the website <a href="http://reg.psu.ac.th">http://reg.psu.ac.th</a> .

#### 4. Required Application Documents and Upload Instructions

- 4.1 A copy of the high school transcript or equivalent (1 set), certified as a true copy and signed.
- 4.2 A copy of the national ID card (front side only) or student ID card (must include the 13-digit national ID number), certified as a true copy and signed.
- 4.3 Portfolio (maximum 10 pages including cover).
- 4.4 Copies of certificates/diplomas (if available), certified as true copies and signed.
- 4.5 English proficiency test results (TOEFL, IELTS, CAE, FCE, TU-GET, or CU-TEP), if applicable.

##### Remarks:

Applicants must upload all required documents (from items 4.1 to 4.5) as a single PDF file, no larger than 25 MB, to the system via <https://e-admission.psu.ac.th> by **7 November 2024**. Incomplete or unclear document submissions will result in an invalid application.

#### 5. Selection Process

- 5.1 The university (through the faculty) will first check the general qualifications (Section 1) and specific qualifications (Section 2) of the applicants. If any applicant does not meet the faculty or program's requirements, they will not proceed to the next step.
- 5.2 If the number of applicants exceeds the available slots, the faculty will select candidates by ranking them based on their cumulative GPAX and other supporting documents submitted for the interview. This decision will be made at the discretion of the committee.
- 5.3 Once applicants pass the preliminary qualification check (as per 5.1) and are eligible for the interview, the interview committee will conduct interviews in English and consider additional supporting documents (as indicated in Section 4). The committee will also evaluate the portfolio. Based on the interview assessment, the committee will make the final decision on which candidates are admitted.

##### Remarks:

Those selected for this program must continue their studies in the Innovation Engineering and Management (International Program). They cannot transfer to another program.

The decision of the Faculty of Engineering selection committee is final.

#### 6. Graduation Requirements from Prince of Songkla University

- 6.1 Students must complete all required courses and evaluations according to the curriculum, program requirements, and university regulations.
- 6.2 Students must pass the English proficiency test, meeting the minimum standards set by Prince of Songkla University.
- 6.3 Students must participate in extracurricular activities for personal development as required by the university.
