



Prince of Songkla University Announcement
Subject: Undergraduate Admission and Selection for the Faculty of Engineering,
Rubber Engineering (International Program)
Under the Portfolio Academic Project Group for the Academic Year 2025 (Round 1/2)

The Faculty of Engineering at Prince of Songkla University wishes to open applications and select individuals for undergraduate studies in the Bachelor Degree Program in Rubber Engineering (International Program), Academic year 2025 Round 1/2. Details are as follows:

1. General qualifications of applicants

- 1.1 The applicant is currently studying in Matthayom 6 with an emphasis on Science and Mathematics Program
- 1.2 The applicant must not have any serious contagious diseases or significant health conditions that would hinder their studies or future career.
- 1.3 The applicant must have an academic portfolio or other relevant achievements.
- 1.4 The applicant must demonstrate good conduct and behavior.
- 1.5 The applicant must meet the minimum academic and specific qualifications set by the faculty/program.
- 1.6 If the applicant does not fully meet the criteria in sections 1.1–1.5, the decision will be at the discretion of the selection committee.

Conditions and Special Privileges

Scholarships: 3 scholarships available

1. Selection of Scholarship Recipients

The recipients will be selected based on the following qualifications:

1.1 Applicant is currently studying in Matthayom 6 with a focus on science and mathematics courses and have academic results for 5 semesters as follows:

- 1.1.1 Mathematics: Not less than 2.80
- 1.1.2 Science and Technology: Not less than 3.00
- 1.1.3 Foreign Languages: Not less than 2.80

1.2 Must have a cumulative (GPAX) for 5 semesters from Matthayom 5-6 of not less than 2.80.

2. Scholarship Award

Recipients will receive a scholarship of 10,000 THB per semester. If, in subsequent semesters, the student cannot maintain a cumulative GPA of 3.25, the scholarship will be revoked.

Remarks:

1. Scholarship recipients will be eligible to receive the scholarship for a maximum of 8 semesters, and students must enroll in courses according to their study plan or at least 18 credits in the 6 regular semesters (except for 4th-year students, for whom the faculty will make decisions on a case-by-case basis if they do not follow the study plan).
2. If a scholarship recipient withdraws or transfers to another faculty, they must repay the full amount of the scholarship they received to the faculty.

3. Conditions for Maintaining Admission Eligibility

3.1 The selected student must complete Matthayom 6 at their current school and maintain the academic performance level required by the faculty/department.

3.2 After completing Grade 12, the student must have completed the following credit requirements:

- 1) Science and Technology: Must complete at least 22 credits from core and elective courses.
- 2) Mathematics: Must complete at least 12 credits from core and elective courses.
- 3) Foreign Languages: Must complete at least 9 credits from core and elective courses.

If the student does not meet the conditions in sections 3.1 and 3.2, the university may cancel their admission, even if they have already been announced as an eligible student.

3. Application Schedule

2-19 December 2024	Applicants must register for a username and password through the website at https://e-admission.psu.ac.th .
	Online application submission and information editing can be done through the website at https://e-admission.psu.ac.th . The system closes at 11:00 PM on the application deadline date.
	The application fee of 300 THB must be paid by scanning the QR Code through a bank's mobile application as displayed on the payment page. The payment must be completed by 11:59 PM. The university will not refund the application fee under any circumstances.

5 - 6 February 2025	Selected applicants must confirm their admission via the TCAS system at https://student.mycas.com under the Council of University Presidents of Thailand.
11 February 2025	The university will announce the list of admitted students on the website https://admission.psu.ac.th .
May – June 2025	Students must officially register and pay their tuition fees. Further details can be followed on the website http://reg.psu.ac.th .

4. Required Application Documents and Upload Instructions

- 4.1. A copy of the high school transcript or equivalent (1 set), certified as a true copy and signed.
- 4.2. A copy of the national ID card (front side only) or student ID card (must include the 13-digit national ID number), certified as a true copy and signed.
- 4.3. Portfolio (maximum 10 pages including cover).
- 4.4. Copies of certificates/diplomas (if available), certified as true copies and signed.

Remarks:

Applicants must upload all required documents (from items 4.1 to 4.4) as a single PDF file, no larger than 25 MB, to the system via <https://e-admission.psu.ac.th>. Incomplete or unclear document submissions will result in an invalid application.

5. Selection Process

- 5.1 The university (through the faculty) will preliminarily verify the general qualifications (section 1) and specific qualifications (section 2) of the applicants. If any applicant does not meet the qualifications set by the faculty/department, they will not proceed to the next stage of consideration.
- 5.2 In the case where the number of applicants exceeds the announced intake, the faculty will select candidates based on the interview and supporting documents submitted by the applicants, at the discretion of the committee.
- 5.3 Once an applicant has been selected as eligible for an interview, the faculty committee will conduct the interview to assess their academic readiness and review other documents (if any).

Remarks:

Those selected for this program must continue their studies in the Rubber Engineering (International Program). They cannot transfer to another program.

The decision of the Faculty of Engineering selection committee is final.

6. Graduation Requirements from Prince of Songkla University

- 6.1 Students must complete all required courses and evaluations according to the curriculum, program requirements, and university regulations.
- 6.2 Students must pass the English proficiency test, meeting the minimum standards set by Prince of Songkla University.
- 6.3 Students must participate in extracurricular activities for personal development as required by the university.
