



Prince of Songkla University Announcement

Direct Admission Channel for Students in Bachelor of “Evolution of International Dietitian Program” Under the Portfolio General Project Group for the Academic Year 2025 (Round 1/2)

The Faculty of Agro-Industry, Prince of Songkla University, intends to proceed with the enrollment of students for the project “Evolution of International Dietitian Program” to hire individuals for studies in the Faculty of Agro-Industry, specializing under Dietetics and Nutrition for Health (International Program) for the academic year 2025 (Round 1/2 Portfolio), Details are as follows:

1. General Qualifications of applicants

- 1.1 **Students from the domestic school system** are those who are currently studying or have graduated from high school with a focus on science and mathematics subjects.
- 1.2 **Students in the international School system:** Applicants who are currently studying or have completed high school or an equivalent level from an international education system institution, either in Thailand or abroad and/or have passed an educational qualification equivalency examination as follows:
 - IGCSE (International General Certificate of Secondary Education): Successfully completed 5 subjects with no repetition, each subject with a grade not less than C. or
 - GED (General Educational Development): Passed 4 subjects with a minimum score of 145 points per subject or
 - IB (International Baccalaureate): Obtained a score not less than 29 or
 - Have standardized test scores as follows: ACT: Scored not less than 23 or SAT: Scored not less than 1,000 or equivalent or
 - Secured at least 40% in English, Mathematics and Science on the National Test.
- 1.3 Applicants must not have any serious contagious diseases or conditions that would hinder their studies or future career.
- 1.4 Applicants must have good conduct.
- 1.5 Applicants must have academic results and specific qualifications not lower than the criteria set by the faculty/program.
- 1.6 For those who wish to apply for study but do not meet the qualifications in 1.1 -1.5, the selection committee will consider and/or according to the approval of the committee, which will consider each individual case.

17 January 2025	Interviews.
23 January 2025	The list of successful interviewees will be announced on the website https://agro.psu.ac.th
5 - 6 February 2025	Selected applicants must confirm their admission via the TCAS system at https://student.mytcas.com under the Council of University Presidents of Thailand.
11 February 2025	The university will announce the list of admitted students on the website https://admission.psu.ac.th
May - June 2025	Students must officially register and pay their tuition fees. Further details can be followed on the website http://reg.psu.ac.th

4. Required Application Document and Upload Instructions

- A copy of the high school transcript from the final year of high school.
- A copy of the national ID card (front side only) or student ID card (must include the 13-digit national ID number).
- Portfolio (maximum 10 pages including cover.)

Remarks: applicants must upload all required documents as a single PDF file, no larger than 25 MB, to the system via <https://e-admission.psu.ac.th>. Incomplete or unclear document submissions will result in an invalid application.

5. Selection Process

- 5.1 The university (through the faculty) will first check the general qualifications (Section 1) and specific qualifications (Section 2) of the applicants. If any applicant does not meet the faculty or program's requirements, they will not proceed to the next step.
- 5.2 If the number of applicants exceeds the available slots, the faculty will select candidates by ranking them based on their cumulative GPAX and other supporting documents submitted for the interview. This decision will be made at the discretion of the committee.
- 5.3 Once applicants pass the preliminary qualification check and are eligible for the interview, the interview committee will conduct interviews and consider additional supporting documents. The committee will also evaluate the portfolio.

The interview scoring criteria are as follows:

1. Portfolio - General Qualifications : Assessment based on the academic performance, extracurricular activities, and special abilities.	20
2. Interview (Conducted in English): <ul style="list-style-type: none">- General knowledge in the field of food and nutrition- Attitude towards working in health-related organizations such as hospitals, child-care facilities, and elderly care centers.- Collaborative work attitude within interdisciplinary teams, including doctors, pharmacists, and nurses.- Proficiency in the English language.	10 15 20 20

Admission Criteria: The passing score is 70%, ranked as not exceeding the intake quota. In the case of tied scores, the decision at the discretion of the selection committee. The committee's decision is final once the university announces the results. The applicants or others are not allowed to appeal or claim any rights on the same.

The decision of the selection committees of Prince of Songkla University is final.

6. Graduation Requirements from Prince of Songkla University

- 6.1 Students must complete all required courses and evaluations according to the curriculum, program requirements, and university regulations.
- 6.2 Students must pass the English proficiency test, meeting the minimum standards set by Prince of Songkla University.
- 6.3 Students must participate in extracurricular activities for personal development as required by the university.
